Reception for boys

Boys move seamlessly to Reception and the curriculum is tailored to their needs with an emphasis on creative, collaborative teaching where boys are challenged to take risks and become resilient. Learning to read, write and understand number are all prioritised for the best attainment at the end of the EYFS.

Independence and nurture

We support and nurture our children to become independent in everyday tasks and skills recognising that time, patience and role modelling is required.

Everyday skills such as toilet training, selecting their snack, packing bags, changing for swimming, putting on shoes and using utensils at lunchtime are all prioritised to give children the independence to move to the next stage in their educational journey with confidence.



Discover through play

Our spacious well-resourced classrooms create the opportunities for our children to learn and discover through play. Well planned learning experiences and spontaneous child led play both inside and outside ensure children learn to make independent decisions and take their learning to the next level. They are taught to respect resources, listen and share with their peers.



Set in the middle of 45 acres, EYFS children have regular use of the woodland forest school area, swimming pool, gym, playgrounds, church, Performance Hall, music room and library. A hot lunch which is prepared daily is served in the salon. All EYFS children can be looked after from 8.00am-5.00pm and termly outings are organised when they travel in the school minibus.
